

**ANIMALS (CONTROL OF IMPORTATION) (AMENDMENT) REGULATION, 1962 (LI 211).**

IN exercise of the powers conferred on the President by section 5 of the Animals (Control of Importation) Ordinance, 1952 (No. 36), this Regulation is made this 22nd day of August, 1962.

Regulation 13 (1) of the regulations contained in the First Schedule to the Animals (Control of Importation) Ordinance, 1952 (No. 36) is hereby amended as follows :—

(a) by the omission from paragraph (b) (vi) of the words "dogs and"; and

(b) by the insertion immediately after paragraph (b) (vi) of the following :—

“(vii) in respect of dogs, that they are healthy and free from infectious disease; that they were inoculated against rabies not more than six months prior to the date of importation, or come from an area which has been free from rabies for a period of six months prior to the date when they leave their country of origin; and either that they are in the opinion of the person issuing the certificate not less than five months of age or that their country of origin is one in which the disease of rabies is not known to exist.”
