

PHARMACY AND DRUGS (AMENDMENT OF SCHEDULE) INSTRUMENT, 1961 (LI 157).

IN exercise of the powers conferred on the Minister by section 60 of the Pharmacy and Drugs Act, 1961 (Act 64), and after consulting the Pharmacy Board, this Instrument is made this 1st day of November, 1961.

The First Schedule to the Pharmacy and Drugs Act, 1961 (Act 64), is hereby amended, by the addition, at the end of the list of the "Exempted Drugs", of the following:—

“Adhesives; anti-fouling compositions; builder's materials; ceramics; distempers; electrical valves; enamels; explosives; fillers; fireworks; glazes; glue; inks lacquer solvents; loading materials; matches; medicated soaps; motor fuels and lubricants; paints other than pharmaceutical paints; photographic paper; pigments; plastics; propellants; rubber; varnishes; substances containing less than 10 per cent of chloroform. Preparations containing chloroxylenol and its derivatives”.
